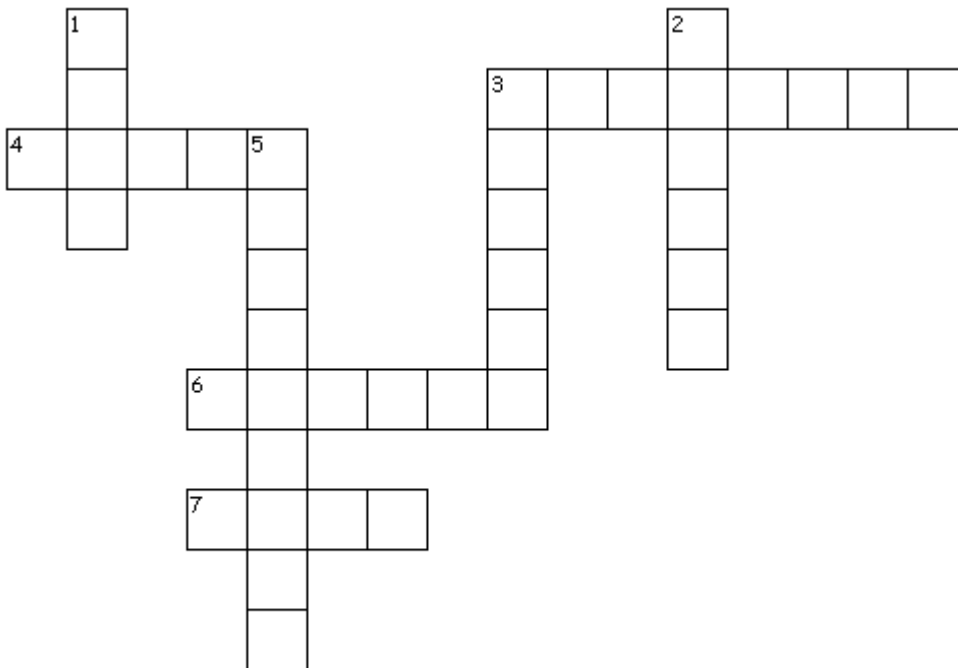

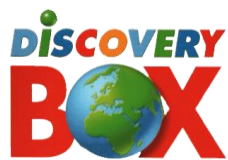
Comprehension and Vocabulary
