4. Was the boys' visit beneficial to Tristan? How do you know?

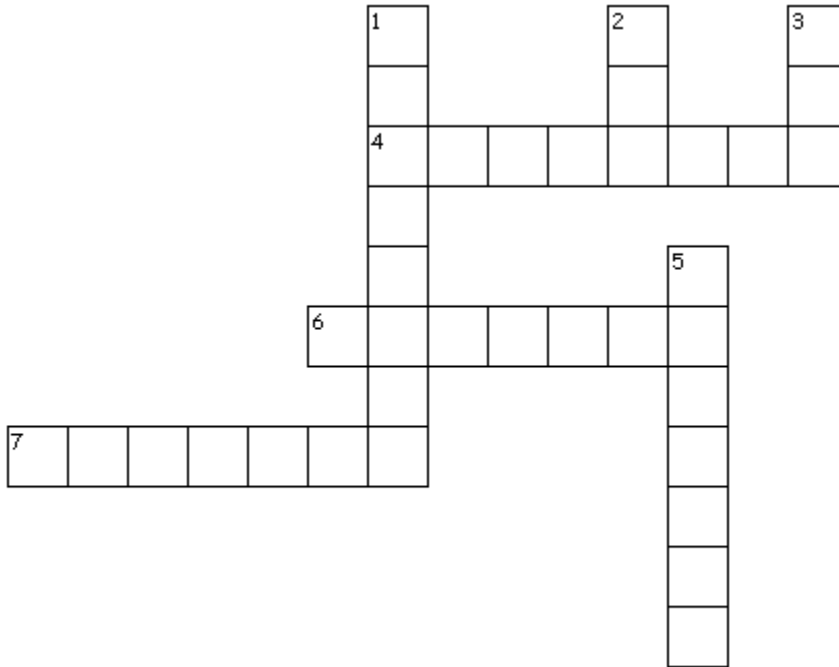
5. How did Mrs. Baker find out who the secret visitors were?
